How To Apply Online For Just Medicare

You can apply online for Medicare even if you are not ready to retire. You can use our online application to sign up. It takes less than 10 minutes. There are no forms to sign and usually no documentation is required. Social Security will process your application and contact you if we need more information.

Medicare is managed by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Social Security works with CMS by enrolling people in Medicare.

Benefits Application Terms of Service

I understand that I am entering a U.S. Government System to file a benefit application with the Social Security Administration. I understand that I need to provide the Social Security Administration information to process the benefit application. I understand that failing to agree to the statements below will result in my inability to file a benefit application online, which may prevent the Social Security Administration from making an accurate and timely decision about eligibility for benefits.

I understand that:

- the Social Security Administration will validate the information I provide against the information in Social Security Administration's systems.
- · my activities may be monitored within this site.
- any person who knowingly and willfully tries to obtain Social Security benefits falsely could be punished by a fine or imprisonment, or both.
- I am authorized to file a claim on my own behalf or on behalf of someone else with the Social Security Administration.

enrollment process and you will need a cell phone to get the text message with a access code they send to you.

- 9. Create a user name and password and answer the questions, if you are successful they will send you a code to access your account, the Medicare application is next and it is easy and takes less than 10 minutes to complete.
- 10. Make sure you write down your reentry number in case you need to check on the status of your enrollment.
